A Proud Moment – Madhyamik Success!

We are overjoyed to share that four girls – two from Kolkata and two from a remote village – under our care since the beginning, have successfully passed their Madhyamik (10th-grade) examinations! These girls, once vulnerable and at risk of dropping out, have rewritten their futures with hard work and your support. Their achievements were featured in numerous news stories, highlighting the power of sustained care and education.



Learning Centres Near Completion

The construction of our Ramdhanu Learning Centres in remote tribal villages is nearly complete. With doors, windows, and plastering done, these centres are turning into beautiful, safe spaces for education and creativity.



New Beginnings in Murgaboni



Regular classes have now officially started in the tribal village of Murgaboni, offering structured learning alongside nutritious meals. Children are now grouped by learning levels, ensuring tailored education that truly makes a difference.

Summer Camps Bursting with Joy

Summer camps are in full swing – both in-house and at partner locations. From storytelling and music to dance and science experiments, our children are experiencing joyful, holistic learning in a vibrant environment.



Rabindra Jayanti Celebration

We celebrated Rabindra Jayanti with songs, poetry, and performances that reflected the spirit of Tagore. The children's energy and creativity lit up the day and reminded us of the power of culture in shaping young minds.



Street Children – A Mission in Motion



Every day, our dedicated interns and team members reach out to more than 100 street children, offering not just food and educational materials, but dignity, love, and a safe space to learn. We sit with them on pavements, under open skies, because for us – learning has no boundaries.

Impact in Focus

Former child labourers and school dropouts have now passed Madhyamik – a phenomenal transformation and a testament to resilience.

Over 100 street children are now part of our daily outreach – learning, playing, and receiving regular meals and supplies.





More than 35 street children are now receiving full-day shelter at our Ramdhanu Bari shelter home, where they get:

- Nutritious meals
- Clean clothing
- A safe place to rest
- Engaging lessons in academics, crochet, painting, singing, dance, and life skills

500+ sanitary napkins have been distributed among adolescent girls and young women in both Kolkata and tribal villages, promoting menstrual health and dignity.



Anganwadi centres in rural areas are now functioning smoothly with our ongoing support and collaboration.

We are proud to collaborate with Cognizant as part of their outreach volunteer programme, bringing together corporate volunteers and grassroots needs.

Thank you for being part of our journey. Every small step we take together is a leap towards a more equitable and compassionate future.
