Creativity & Learning

No-WiFi Craft & Sewing Workshop – Rabindra Sarovar, Kolkata

A beautiful “No-WiFi Zone” craft and sewing workshop was organized with street children from the Rabindra Sarovar area. Away from screens and distractions, the children immersed themselves in creativity, learning basic stitching, crafts, and teamwork.

Storytelling Session at Village Ramdhanu Centre

A heartwarming storytelling session was held at the village centre. Through stories filled with hope and courage, children explored imagination and improved their listening skills.



Empowering Girls & Women

Tribal Girls Start Earning Through Patchwork Bags

The tribal girls of Murgabuni village who turned 14 began creating beautiful patchwork bags, selling them at exhibitions and earning their first pocket money.

Financial Awareness Session for Village Young Adults

A session on savings, financial independence, and the importance of education was conducted for village youth to address the rising child marriage rate.

Women's Day Celebrations

Women's Day was celebrated at both Kolkata and village centres. The young women of our empowerment unit were treated to a special lunch in appreciation of their dedication.

Tribal Women Training & Growing Stitching Unit

Daily training for tribal women continued, with more women becoming financially independent.

Two Street Girls Find Shelter

Two little girls found on a footpath were brought to Ramdhanu. They now have a safe shelter and have started their basic education.





Education Initiatives

Special Maths & Science Teacher Appointed

A dedicated Maths and Science teacher was appointed at the village centre to support girls struggling academically.

Recognition & Collaboration

Felicitation from German Consulate Kolkata

Ramdhanu received a felicitation along with books to build libraries in both Kolkata and village centres.

Village Women Visit Kolkata for Training

Women from the village travelled to Kolkata to accept the honour and trained girls in stitching.



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Initiative - The Impact We Created

1. **No-WiFi Craft Workshop:** 42 street children participated, 28 learned basic stitching, 35 created their first craft item
2. **Storytelling Session:** 96 village children attended, 18 children started reading independently
3. **Patchwork Bags by Tribal Girls:** 14 girls trained, 120 bags created, ₹18,500 earned collectively
4. **Financial Awareness Session:** 32 young adults attended, 21 opened savings plans
5. **Two Street Girls Rescued:** 2 girls rehabilitated, enrolled in basic education
6. **Women's Day Celebration:** 38 women from empowerment unit celebrated and recognised
7. **German Consulate Felicitation & Books:** 240 books received, 2 libraries strengthened
8. **Village Women Training in Kolkata:** 2 women travelled, 26 girls trained in stitching
9. **Maths & Science Teacher Appointed:** 34 girls receiving special academic support
10. **Tribal Women Stitching Unit:** 27 women trained, 11 women started earning regularly
